

# Cabled Coffee Cup Cozy

Supplies:

Worsted weight yarn	Crochet hook, size 9 or H
Size 8 knitting needles	2 buttons
Cable needle	Large eye needle

Cast on 16 stitches

Row 1: k4, p8, k4

Row 2: k2, p2, 4-st RKC, 4-st LKC, p2, k2

Row 3: k4, p8, k4

Row 4: k2, p2, k8, p2, k2

Row 5: k4, p8, k4

Row 6: k2, p2, 4-st RKC, 4-st LKC, p2, k2

Row 7: k4, p8, k4

Row 8: k2, p2, k8, p2, k2

Row 9: k4, p8, k4

Row 10: k2, p2, 4-st LKC, 4-st RKC, p2, k2

Row 11: k4, p8, k4

Row 12: k2, p2, k8, p2, k2

Row 13: k4, p8, k4

Row 14: k2, p2, 4-st LKC, 4-st RKC, p2, k2

Row 15: k4, p8, k4

Row 16: k2, p2, k8, p2, k2

Row 17: k4, p8, k4

Repeat rows 2-17 three more times

Repeat rows 2-14 once more

Bind off all stitches



Stitch Legend:

**k**-knit

**p**-purl

**4-st RKC**- Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 stitches from left needle, knit 2 stitches from cable needle.

**4-st LKC** - Slip next 2 stitches to cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 2 stitches from left needle, knit 2 stitches from cable needle.

Make two crochet chain loops to sew on one end of the piece. You will want to have a coffee cup that you can use as a guide to determine where to sew the buttons.
