

## FINDING YOUR ITEM IN THE BROOME COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY

**F (Fiction) + name of author** ( F Grisham,etc.), your item is fiction and it will be located in the main fiction collection in the middle of the building on the Court street side. Fiction is shelved alphabetically by the author's last name.

**(Large Print) + name of author** (LP Scottoline,, etc.) your item will be located on the Court Street side of the building in the farthest shelves away from the colonnade in the corner in the **Large Print section**.

**PF (Paperback Fiction) + name of author** or **LPF (Large Print Paperback Fiction) + name of author** (PF Hart; LPF Anderson, etc.). Your item will be located on the **standing rotating displays** towards the front of the building on the Court street side across from the Circulation desk.

**Television series** are shelved in the **Reference area** on the Court street side alphabetically by the name of the show.

**Fiction DVD, VHS cassette** or **foreign films**, your item will be located towards the front of the building near the windows on the Court street side.

**YA (Young Adult) + name of author**, it will be located at the very front of the building to the right of the entrance/exit on the Court street side of the building.

**Urban Fiction**, it will be located in the middle of the floor between the Circulation desk and the windows on the Court street side of the building.

**New Display**, it will be located on the metal shelving on your left when you are coming into the library and opposite the Circulation desk.

**Book on CD**, it will be located in the Front corner of the building and to the right of the Young Adult collection on the Court street side.

**Dewey Decimal number + author**, it is **non-fiction** and will be located on the Pine Street side of the Reference area. Locate it by looking at the numbers on the sides of the bookcases, then the author of the item in alphabetical order.

**Q (Oversized) + Dewey Decimal number** (Q432.112 Jenson, etc.), it will be located on the outside wall on the Pine street side of the library. Locate your number by looking at the spines of the books first and then by the author in alphabetical order.

**Civil Service Examination preparation book**, it will be located to the left of the Reference desk opposite where the newspapers are kept.

**DVD or VHS cassette** and has a **Dewey Decimal number**, it will be located in the bookshelves at the front of the Reference area near the elevator on the Court street side of the building.

**Music CD**, it will be located at the very front of the building near the windows and across from the Circulation desk.

**R (Reference) + Dewey Decimal number**, it will be located in the Reference Collection on the Court street side of the building to the left of the Reference desk.

**Dewey Decimal number + Ahearn**, it will be located in the **J. Donald Ahearn Business Center** to the left of the Reference Desk in **Room 138** on the Court Street side of the building.

**Newspaper** or a **magazines**, are shelved to the left of the Reference Desk on the Court street side of the building.

**LP (Large Print) + Dewey Decimal number** or **QLP (Oversized Large Print) + Dewey Decimal number**, it will be located in the Large Print section in the middle of the building on the Court Street side in the corner.

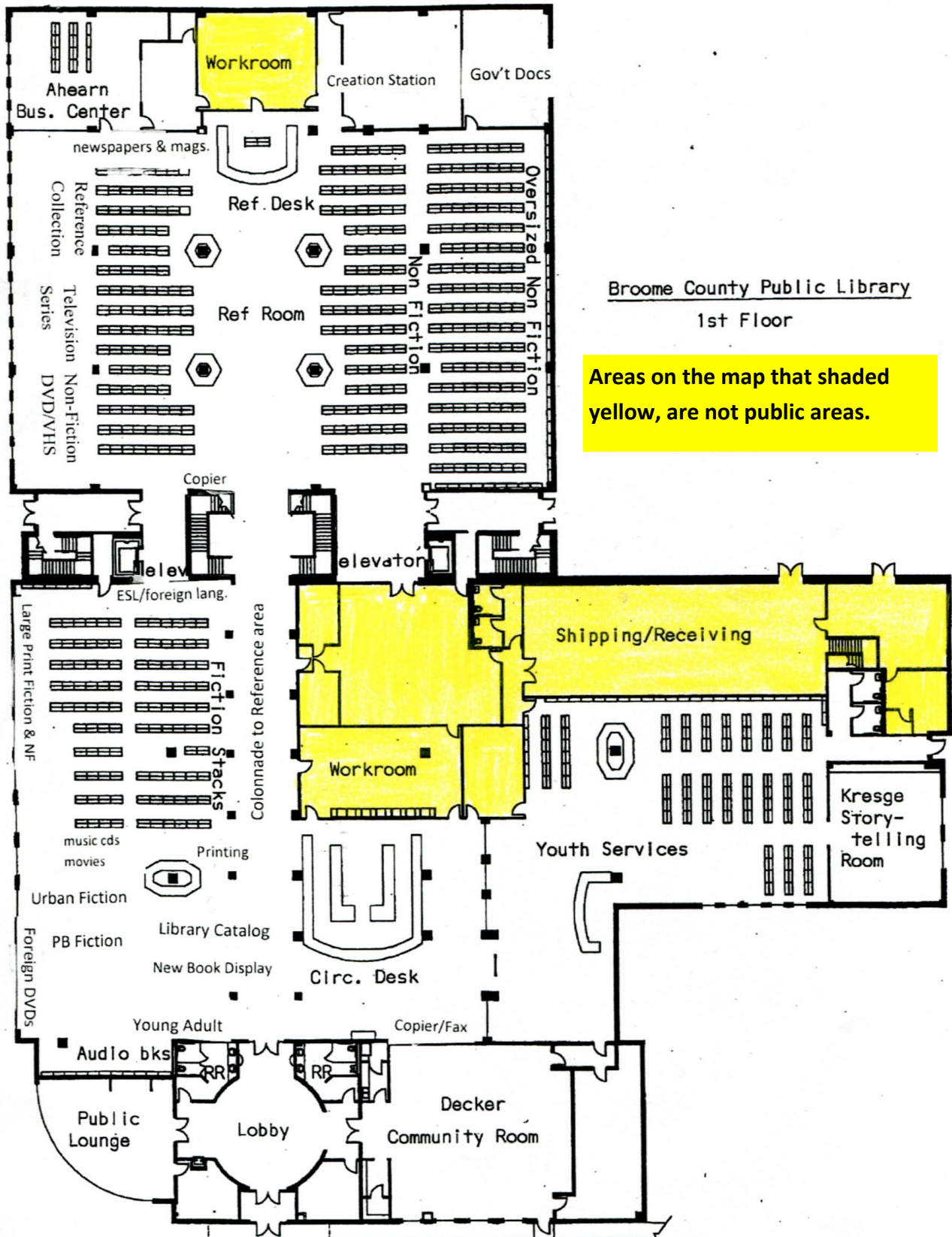
**J (Juvenile)**, it will be located in the Children's area to the right of the Circulation Desk on the Pine street side of the building.

**YA (Young Adult) + Dewey Decimal number**, it is located in the Young Adult section at the very front of the library to the right of the entrance/exit on the Court street side of the building.

**Dewey Decimal number + Local History**, it will be located on the second floor in the **Local History and Genealogy Center**. These items cannot be checked out.

**ESL/EFL book or DVDs/Cassettes for learning a language other than English**, it will be located on the back wall of the Circulation area of the library to the left of the arch leading to the Reference area.

**(B [Biography] + name)**, it will be located in the Biography Collection after the 900s on the Pine street side of the Reference area or in the other non-fiction shelving (**Dewey Decimal number + author**).
